Office McElwee said they will be monitoring the crosswalk in front of the old Safeway site after receiving multiple complaints of people not stopping for pedestrians. It is a \$250 fine plus points on your license.

President's Report

Jenny reminded everyone that she was appointed president when Tricia Duncan decided to run for the Ward 3 council seat. She thanked everyone who came and who helped with the easter egg hunt. It was a huge success and brought in 14 new household members! She said the PCA is teaming up with the Chevy Chase Citizens Association to host a virtual Ward 3 candidates forum. Committee Reports

Transportation: Jack Wells reported that the ANC3D Transportation Committee is meeting on Thursday and will discuss three items: (1) proposed restrictions during rush hour on Chain Bridge Rd and University Ter. (2) sidewalk construction and (3) proposed bike lanes in the neighborhood.

Jack also mentioned that ANC Commissioner Michael Siriqui sent an email to DDOT about the arrow light at the bottom of Loughboro heading left on MacArthur being too short. DDOT realized that the walk signal was broken and fixed the problem. This means the green cycle should be improved.

TCC: Lisa DeBow couldn't make it, so Jenny updated the membership. She said work will begin on May 2.
